

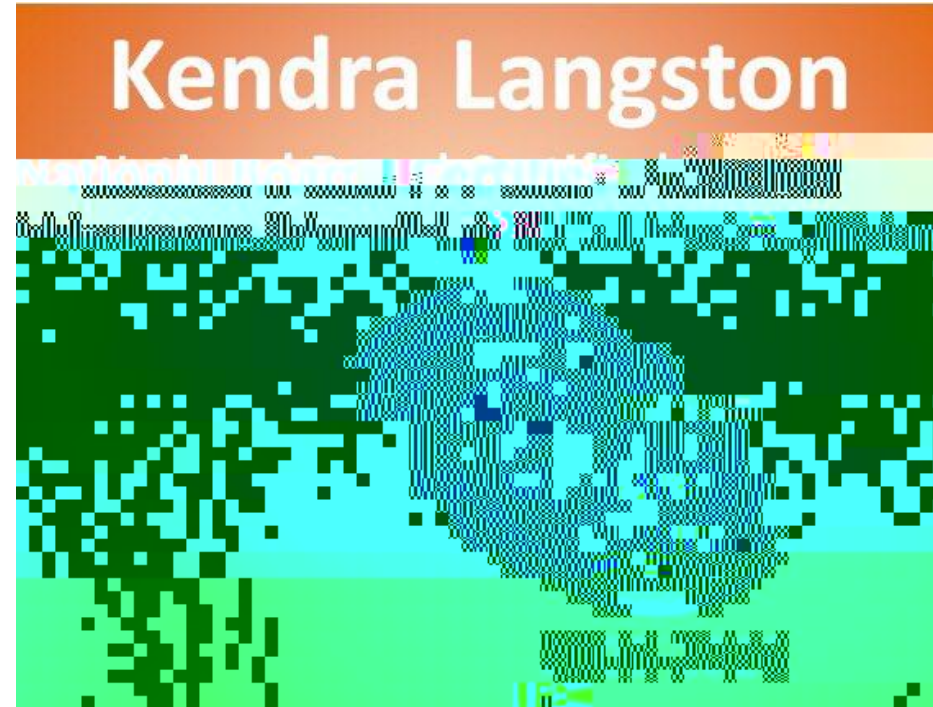

5 Core Propositions

1. Professionalism and Ethics
Teachers are committed to the highest ethical standards and professional conduct. They are members of a profession that is dedicated to the public good and the well-being of their students.

2. Content Knowledge and Pedagogical Skill
Teachers possess deep content knowledge and pedagogical skill. They understand the subject matter they teach and use effective instructional practices to engage and support all learners.

3. Student Learning and Assessment
Teachers are focused on student learning and use assessment to inform instruction. They monitor student progress and adjust their teaching to meet the needs of individual learners.

4. Collaboration and Leadership
Teachers collaborate with colleagues and lead in their schools. They work together to improve instruction and create a positive school culture.

5. Professional Growth and Development
Teachers engage in ongoing professional growth and development. They seek out opportunities for learning and stay current in their field.

Financial Support

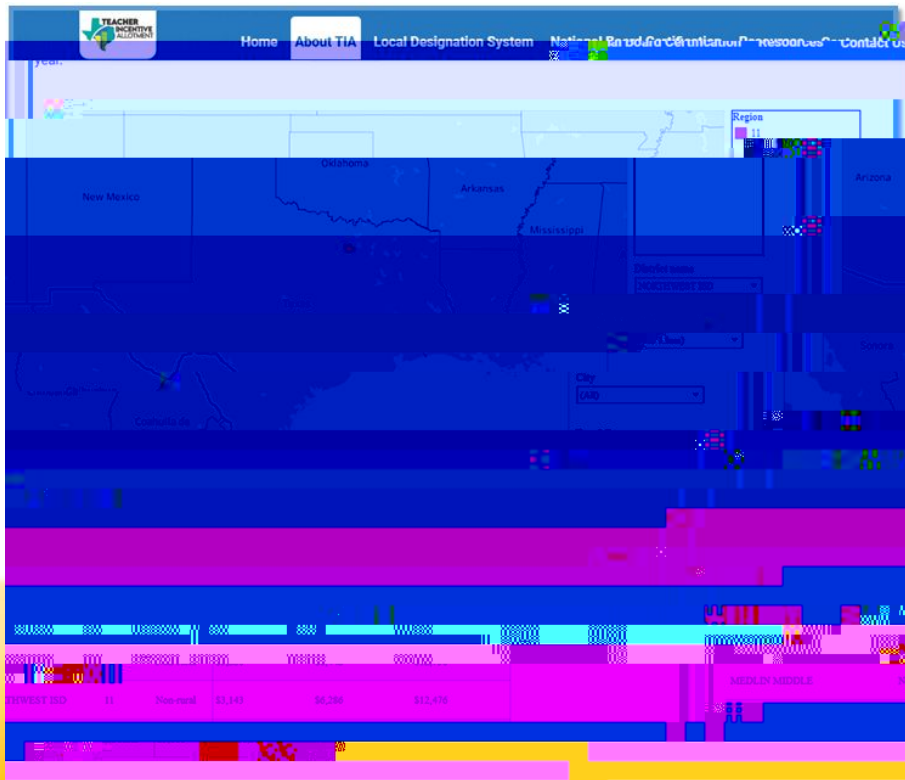
Districts and TEA will support teachers financially

Each component costs \$495.00

Districts can request reimbursement from TEA on behalf of the teacher.

Once a teacher passes all components of the National Board Certification, the district will reimburse the teacher for the \$1900.00 fees.

Teachers will pay the \$75.00 registration fee



TIA Categories

Recognized Teachers

\$3,000 - \$9,000 annually

Exemplary Teachers

Up to \$18,000 annually

Master Teachers

Up to \$32,000 annually
