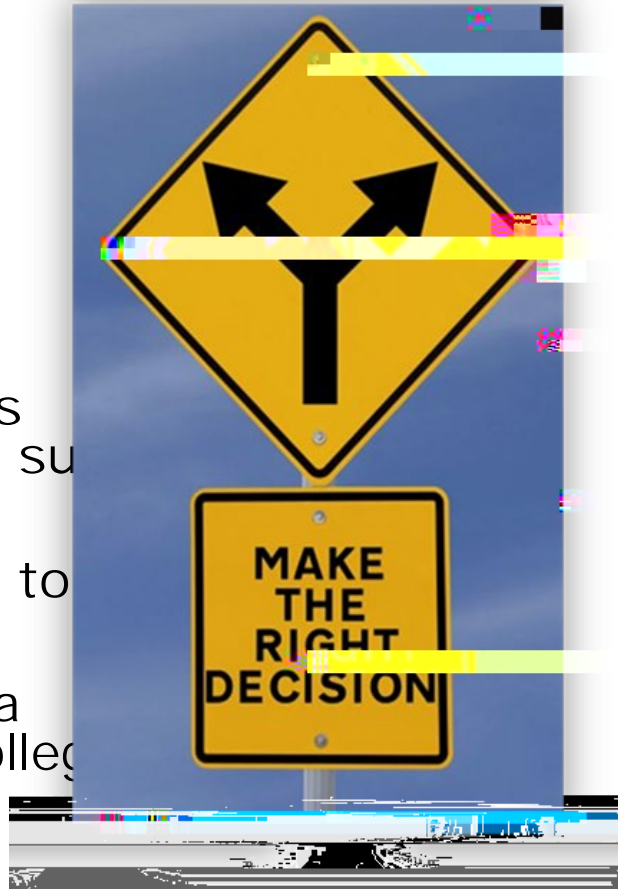

- You test every year.

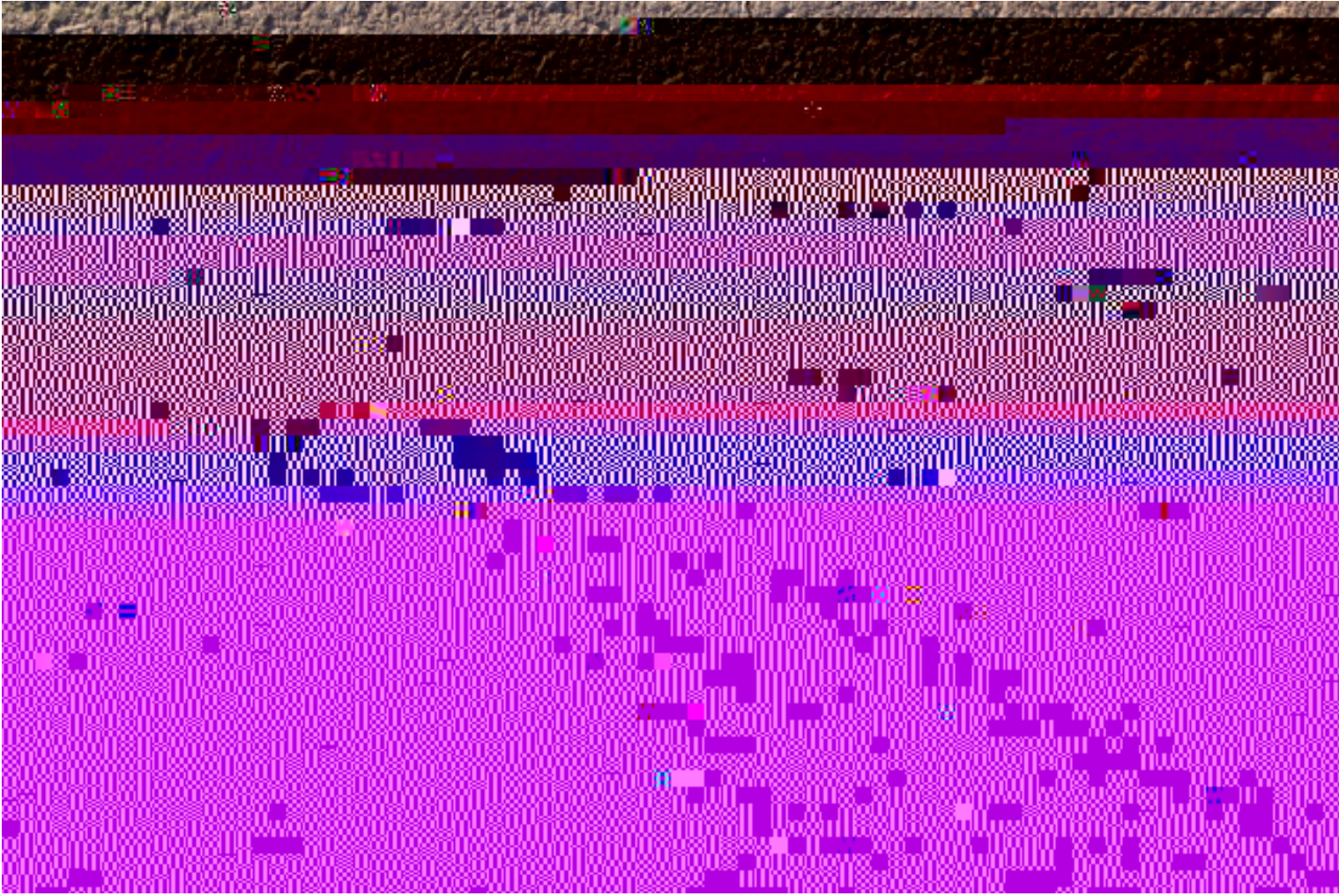

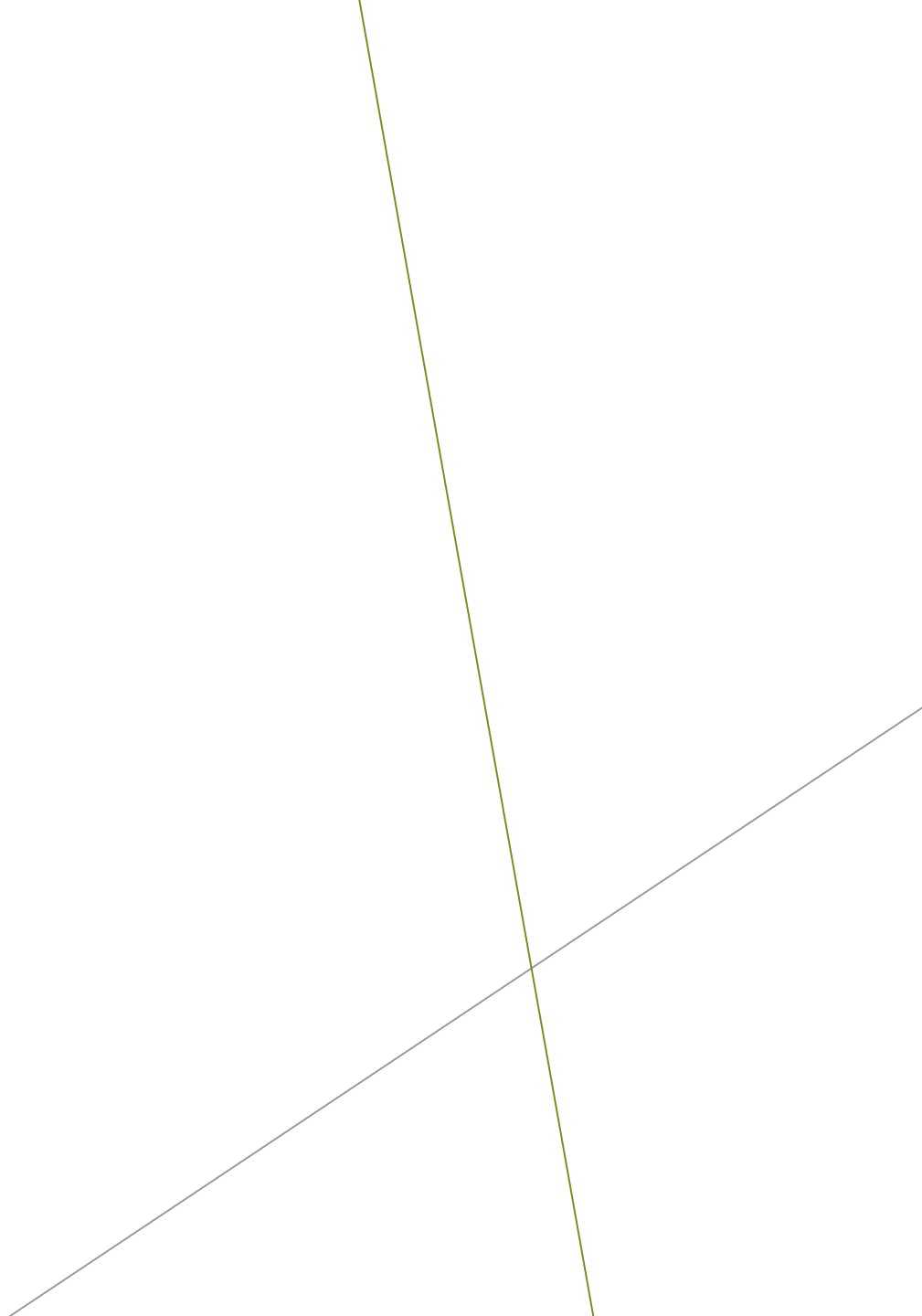

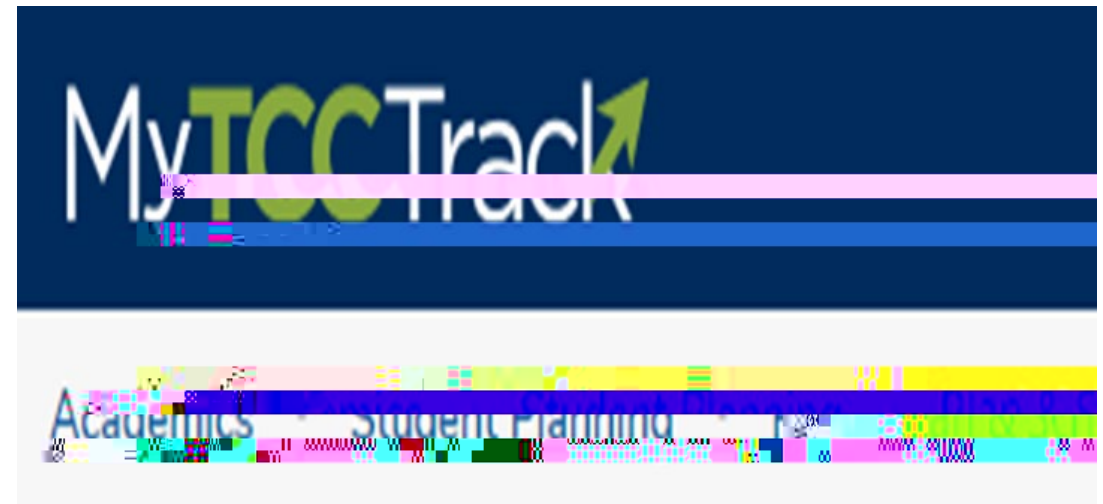


REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Confirm with your high school counselor which specific course(s) you will be taking.

Attend a self-registration session at Birdville High School this spring.

You are not signed up for TCC dual credit courses until you receive your confirmation email at your TCC email account.



PAY FOR YOUR CLASSES

You must pay for your classes EACH semester. If you miss the payment deadline, you will be dropped from the course.

You can pay for classes online or in person at TCC's business services office.

TCC has payment plans available.





DUAL CREDIT GRANT

The Dual Credit Grant is available on a first-come-first-serve basis to students who qualify financially.

Complete the FAFSA and the one-page TCC Dual Credit Grant Application which can be found on TCC's website.

STUDENT ACCESSIBILITY RESOURCES
