

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF  
IMMUNITY OF VOLUNTEER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS**

As you are aware, many of the physicians and health care providers that assist with the care of \_\_\_\_\_ (*name of school or ISD*) athletes volunteer their time to provide physical examinations and medical screening.

Texas state law provides that:

A health care practitioner who, without compensation or expectation of compensation, conducts a physical examination or medical screening of a patient eligible to participate in a school sponsored extracurricular or sporting activity is immune from civil liability for any act or omission resulting in the death or injury to the patient if:

- (1) the health care practitioner was acting in good faith and in the course and
  
- (2) the health care practitioner commits the act or omission in the course of conducting the physical examination or medical screening of the patient;
